

Bequest Fact Sheet

Thank you for considering leaving a bequest to ANHF. You may wish to speak to your legal advisor about the benefits of leaving a charitable bequest. We also ask that you contact us to let us know of your intended gift.

Types of bequest

These are some common ways to include a charitable legacy in your will.

A specific sum of money.

A percentage of your estate – this bequest changes through inflation or value of your estate as the years progress but does not affect the priority or importance of your bequest.

The remainder of your estate – this involves leaving the remainder of an estate after family and friends have been provided for, after meeting all your personal commitments.

A specific bequest – this could include a stated dollar amount, real estate, shares, or physical assets: jewellery, artwork, objects etc.

Your will is a legal document and ANHF recommends that you **seek professional legal advice** to ensure that your exact wishes are carried out.
