Dear Residents and Relatives,

COVID-19 Update #11

The outbreak of COVID-19 continues in Victoria and an outbreak has been detected in South Western Sydney, associated with the Crossroads Hotel in Casula last week. Due to the increasing risk of COVID-19 in the community, NSW Health has directed all residential aged care facilities to maintain vigilance to prevent the introduction of COVID-19 into our facilities.

You should NOT visit any facility if

- You have fever or respiratory symptoms, even mild. You should isolate at home and seek COVID-19 testing;
- You are waiting for COVID-testing result;
- You have household members who are in isolation or pending COVID-19 testing result;
- You have travelled to Melbourne / Victoria in the previous 14 days;
- You have household members or have close contact with people who have travelled to Melbourne in the previous 14 days;
- You reside in one of the following local government areas: Liverpool Campbelltown, Wingecarribee and Wollondilly (Postcodes: 1871, 2170, 2560, 2570, 2571, 2575, 2576, 2577, 2578, 2579);

What should you expect to see happening if the risks of COVID-19 in the community increase?

Due to the sudden in increase in risk, please be alerted that the facility may need to

- cease all visits at a short notice (including cancelling all pre-booked visits) for a period of time or until further notice at the direction of NSW Health; and/or
- require all visitors and staff to wear a surgical mask while in the facility (irrespective of where they live or have visited).

Measures such as phone or video calls would be made available to all residents to enable continuation of communication with family, friends or others who are not allowed to enter the facility at this time. In addition, our Facility Managers will consider all cases compassionately. This includes giving special consideration to end-of-life situations, palliative care and residents with dementia.

We ask for your continuous understanding and cooperation because the risks of COVID-19 in the community poses additional risks to our vulnerable residents.
